

What do we expect from you in the Website Design process?

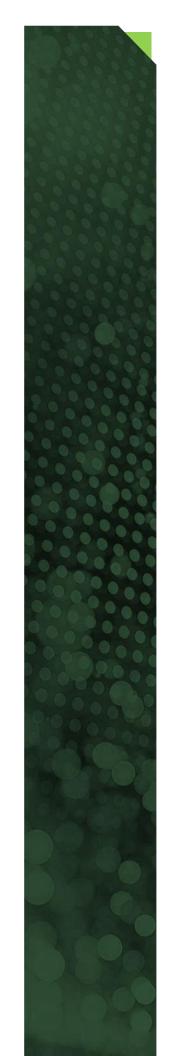
- Your logo, as well as any branding standards and colour schemes you may have.

File Format

Please send us images of the best possible quality. Even though any graphics or photos will be reduced in quality for the web, if you have high-resolution files,

Text documents

The text for your website can be sent to us directly by email, in a Word document, or in raw text format.

If the files aren't too big or many, you can either email us the files directly or supply them in a USB drive or upload them to a service like Dropbox or Google Drive, and then provide us the link.

Note: we only accept files under 10MB by email. Any files larger than 10MB can be supplied by USB drive or Dropbox/Google Drive/ WeTransfer link.
